The Level 1 to Level 3 Courses

Level 1 and Level 2 courses are roughly equivalent to GCSE's with Level 3 courses nearer to A-Level standards. These courses differ from most online learning as there are some progress targets for completion of work necessary. The courses are completed over a 10-12 week period with support available from an Assessor or Learner Support Advisor.

All are accredited by the highly respected awarding organisations - TQUK, NCFE/Cache and ILM - and are nationally recognised accredited qualifications.
